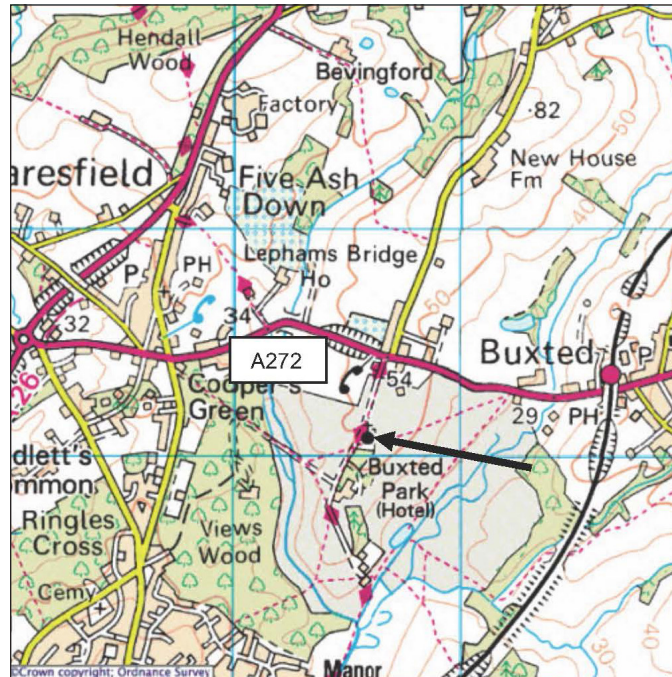

## Finding St Margaret's, Buxted Park

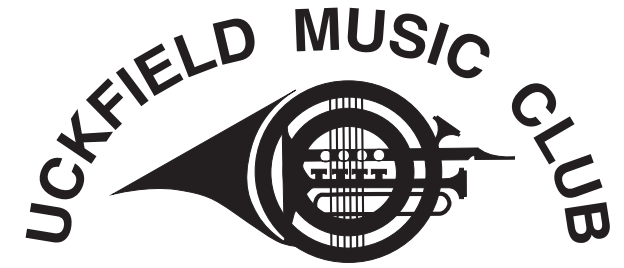
The church is situated on the south side of the A272

the left under the avenue of trees.



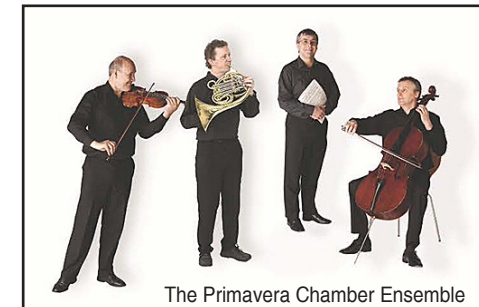

We are delighted to welcome the Primavera back. They are one of the country's premier chamber ensembles, with strong roots in this region, and a feast of fine reviews from their concerts at international festivals in Britain, Europe and beyond.

Their name is Italian for Spring, which reflects the joie de vivre that these musicians bring to their playing. As well as music for piano and strings trio, Primavera will also give us the rich tonal colours of Brahms' Horn Trio.

It seems wholly appropriate to be presenting a young and gifted Syrian-born artist at this time of such strife in his country. Riyad won a scholarship to the Purcell School of Music in 2005 and graduated from the Royal College of Music with distinction in

performance in 2015. His awards include first prize at the Francaix International Piano Competition in Paris, and his performance of Beethoven's 5th piano concerto with the English Chamber Orchestra raised £150,000 for the International Rescue Committee for Syria. He has made his debut at the Wigmore Hall, and performed in major venues including the Royal Albert Hall and Cadogan Hall, and at festivals and concerts all over Britain, and in France, Spain, Switzerland, USA and some Arab States.

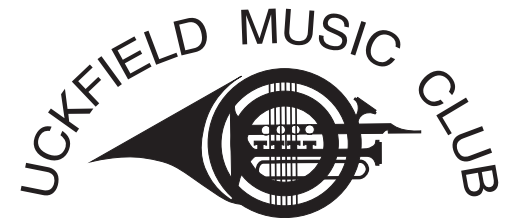

The Frith Piano Quartet was formed in 2000 by a galaxy of the country's top artists - the pianist Benjamin Frith, violinist Robert Heard, violist Louise Williams and 'cellist Richard Jenkinson. The Quartet is a Selected Ensemble of Making Music's Concert Promoters Group. Since its formation the group have performed the complete piano quartets of Brahms, Dvorák, Fauré and Mozart but also take a keen interest in performing gems that are not so often heard in the concert hall by the likes of Frank Bridge, Arthur Bliss and Richard Strauss. Recent concerts have been at both the Buxton and the Paxton Festivals. Future engagements include King's Place and Wigmore Hall. The quartet artists are joined for the lovely Hummel and Schubert quintets by distinguished bassist John Tattersdill.
